REDS



IL MERIDIONE NERO D'AVOLA 2018 (ITALY)

\$57

A deeply colored, medium-bodied, spicy red with aromas of ripe plum and black cherry. The palate combines warm, juicy red fruit flavors with savory, lightly smoky characters, a hint of bitter chocolate and nip of tannin on the finish.



CHATEAU LA ROSE BELLEVUE BORDEAUX COTES DE BLAYE RED 2016 (FRANCE)

\$57

Intense robe with ruby with vivid reflections. The bouquet develops with red fruit aromas such as cherry and plum with spicy nuances. A supple and round palate with a nice balance of tannins, red fruits and elegant licorice.



UMANI RONCHI MONTIPAGANO MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO DOC 2018 (ITALY)

\$64

Ruby red color with purple reflections, it shows an intense bouquet of fresh red fruit and strawberries; on the palate, a medium bodied wine, with an intense fruit lingering final.



BUENA VISTA SONOMA COUNTY ZINFANDEL 2017 (CALIFORNIA)

Mouth-coating darker fruit flavors of blackberry and brambleberry grace the palate. Firm tannin structure, balanced acidity and a long finish.

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TENUTA DI ARCENO CHIANTI CLASSICO DOCG RISERVA 2016 (ITALY) \$88

The nose exudes exotic spices, licorice and ripe black cherries. On the palate, there is a big, full mouthfeel with nuances of cinnamon, dried cranberries, and candied orange peel. The finish is long and persistent with hints of caramel.



CHATEAU LA GARDE PESSAC LEOGNAN ROUGE 2013 (FRANCE) \$88

Deep, dark in appearance and tinged with crimson. Enticing lusciously ripe, red fruit-laden aromas combine on the bouquet with spicy, even smoky notes, quite typical of this Pessac-Leognan terroir. The lovely ripe fruit brings fleshy, well-balanced character on the palate, underpinned by powerful, rounded tannins, coated in generous richness and well-integrated oak.



ANTONIO MAS SINGLE VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2015 (ARGENTINA) \$78

Fresh and fruity, with balanced concentration of fresh fruits characteristics. Very elegant with a medium bodied palate. An elegant, modern wine that is sophisticated, complex and well structure.




CLOS DE LOS SIETE 2016 (ARGENTINA) \$98

A vibrant ruby red colour, the elegant blend offers amazing aromas of blackberries and plums with spicy floral notes. On the palate, it is balanced and fresh with a pleasant acidity characteristic of the vintage, giving it an excellent capacity to age.

BODEGAS RODA 2015 (SPAIN)

\$135

Deep red, bright and brilliant colour, with a light red colour background. Very expressive of live red fruit. Sensations of fresh cherry, light spices and some earthy wet notes. Medium volume, light but fresh, red fruit, fine tannin. Very delicate and very long. It shows the Atlantic vintage, even more than in 2012.



CHATEAU PUECH HAUT TETE DE BELIER RED 2016 (FRANCE)


Another heavenly wine. A ripe, hedonistic effort that offers lots of minerality, darker fruits, pepper and underbrush, it hits the palate with full-bodied richness, ripe tannins and a gorgeously pure, seamless texture. It's already just about impossible



DOMAINE DE BARGYLUS RED 2012 (SYRIA)

\$145

Deep purple hue, the nose is complex with notes of spices & truffles. There is precision in the mouth with excellent balance between the integrated tannins, the elegant fruit and mineral freshness. The finish is powerful and sustained.



DOMAINE ANNE ET HERVE SIGAUT CHAMBOLLE MUSIGNY 2013(FRANCE)

Full-bodied, rich and complex, Domaine Anne & Hervé Sigaut's Chambolle-Musigny Les Bussières Vieilles Vignes 2013 is a luscious mix of black cherry and stewed plums and just a twist of black pepper.

DOURTHE BEAU MAYNE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018 (FRANCE) \$57

Draped in its brilliant, pale greenish-yellow robe, Beau Mayne boasts a delicate bouquet of fruit and flower aromas. The finish is lively and harmonious. Well-balanced, fresh and elegant.



WILD WAVES MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC (NEW ZEALAND) \$57

Nice and clear wine with green hue, intense aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry developing on the nose. Mouthfeel is fresh and linear, driven by a nice acidity and powerful aromas of citrus and orange peel. Lingering finish on grapefruit.



DOMAINE DE LA BONGRAN 'JEAN THÉVENET' MÂCON VILLAGE 2017 (FRANCE) \$76

Honeyed notes of melon, violets and minerality are all hallmarks of this great Macon. Unlike most others, the wine is rich in extract, weight and intensity, and is best drunk between 2017 – 2022




PIEROPAN CALVARINO SOAVE CLASSICO DOC 2018 (ITALY) \$76

Pale straw yellow, with greenish reflections when young; golden with ageing. The aroma is fresh, flowery with aromas of elder, lemon and cherry. The palate is dry, well balanced and elegant, with tremendous length and finesse.

GRAMONA GESSAMI MUSCAT SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018 (SPAIN) \$78

Great aromatic intensity on the nose reminiscent of a walk in the springtime. It evokes the cool, fresh air, a bunch of white flowers, jasmine, and orange blossom. Aromas of chamomile tea and linden infusions. Apricots, peaches, a citrus breeze. All bound up in a very fragrant, fresh halo. Pleasant on entry, light bodied and silky on the palate.



BELONDRADE QUINTA APOLONIA 2017(SPAIN) \$78

Fresh and fruity, showing a remarkable acidity and an unctuous body. This white wine by Bodegas Belondrade is very smooth, with the herbal component showing more prominence on the palate, complemented by remembrances of citrus and spices. Quinta Apolonia has a long, deliciously bitter finish.



CLOUDY BAY TE KOKO SAUVIGNON BLANC (NEW ZEALAND) \$120

Juicy, with mouth-watering notes of nectarine, kaffir lime and lemongrass. A round and creamy mouthfeel complimented by a gentle minerality, while the nervy acidity contributes to a youthful and vibrant finish.



JEAN ET SÉBASTIEN DAUVISSAT CHABLIS GRAND CRU LES PREUSES 2009 (FRANCE) \$160

The mesmerizing nose encapsulates what Grand Cru Chablis achieves at its pinnacle, offering up notes of meyer lemon, yellow apples, honeysuckles, lees, lime blossoms, white peach, salt-preserved lemon, button, preserved pineapple, dried white flower, chalk and crushed oyster shells.


CAVA PERELADA BRUT RESERVA BLUE FESTIVAL N.V. (SPAIN) \$56

Pale yellow colour. Good bubble detachment. Thanks to its ageing, it has developed a fine aroma with fruit hints. Its well-balanced structure, elegance and sensorial richness form an unmistakable personality.



NINO FRANCO RUSTICO PROSECCO SUPERIORE NV (ITALY) \$65

Nino Franco's non-vintage sparkling Rustico Prosecco is unquestionably the world's finest value in a high quality, Champagne look-alike. The non-vintage, light-bodied Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Rustico offers gorgeously elegant, fresh, lively fruit, notes of bread dough and citrus, and persistent effervescence.



CHÂTEAU DE BERNE TERRES DE BERNE ROSÉ (FRANCE) \$88

Pretty, luminous, salmon-pink robe tinted with gold. Delectable bouquet, with notes of red fruits (strawberry, raspberry, redcurrant). Round, refreshing and perfectly balanced in the mouth, very smooth and



LOUIS ROEDERER BRUT PREMIER (FRANCE) \$150

Rut premium characterizes the timeless louis roeder style with the combination of fresh, truthful and vinous qualities of a fully matured wine. It is a structured wine with a lively attack and a smooth palate.
